

COMMON SITES FOR COMT INTERNSHIP:

Central Ohio Music Therapy, LLC serves a variety of facilities and populations in the Central Ohio and Southeast region of the state. This overview gives you a *glance* at possible facilities and populations you *may* work with during your training.

ATHENS/LANCASTER AREA

Athens County Community Singers (ACCS), "A Choir for All Voices"

 This group is a non-profit organization, which started in 2013. They support an adult group (ACCS) and **Beacon Singers** (see below for rehearsal information). The group was formed to create a community performance opportunity for those with and without disabilities. ACCS meets twice a week for 45 minutes. Documentation is also required for this contract.

Beacon Singers

 This is a transitional choir formed in 2016, which rehearses and performs at Beacon School, 801 W. Union St., Athens. Students meet for a 30-minute rehearsal with documentation required for this contract.

Buckeye Community Services Day Habilitation Program, Jackson, OH

 Located at 220 Morton Dr., Jackson, OH. This contract started in 2014 and currently requires 2 groups each week with several clients receiving 30-minute individual sessions.

Hickory Creek Nursing Home, The Plains, OH

- Located at 51 E. 4th St., The Plains, OH, this site is served 2 times a month for wellness sessions. Groups are conducted on various units in the building.
- Occasionally, the AD will request the therapist to see individuals in their room not able to attend group sessions.

Hopewell Health

 Locations may include: REACH Partial Hospitalization Program (14455 Kimberly Road, Nelsonville, OH) and Nelsonville-York Schools (2 Buckeye Dr. Nelsonville, OH)

COMT Music Therapy Clinics (Athens & Columbus locations)

• Individual clients may be seen in person or via telehealth. Site location depends on client arrangements.

Jackson-Vinton County Head Start

 Therapist sees 5 classes every Tuesday with 2 sets of classes rotating every other week. Head Start classes include 3 - 4 year olds. Sessions last 20 - 25 min with consultation and documentation included in services rendered.



Sprouting Melodies - Award Winning Early Childhood Music Program

- While this program is not specifically music therapy, only board certified music therapists are qualified to serve as the provider for this research-based approach to infant and toddler music classes.
- COMT serves Athens Public Library, 30 Home Street, Athens, OH on the first and third Saturday of every month (September - May). Sometimes the Jackson, Ohio library requests classes.

COLUMBUS AREA

Franklin County YMCA Head Start Classes

Three different centers are served with 2 - 3 classes each. Head Start classes include 3
 - 4 year olds. Each session lasts 25 minutes with 5 minutes for documentation.

The Grand of Dublin

• Located in Dublin, this is a multi-level eldercare facility. Session is 35 minutes long with memory care residents and 10 minutes of documentation.

Mount Carmel Rehab

This inpatient rehab hospital in the Westerville area of Columbus. Sessions are
offered on Thursday mornings in conjunction with the Recreation
Department. Dependent on census and patient needs, the COMT music
therapist can just see 1 group of 4-6 people from 11-12, and potentially add a
private session from 10:30-11.

Ohio Department of Corrections

- Ohio Reformatory for Women- located in Marysville, this is a 2000 capacity prison for women and includes 6 hours weekly of music therapy services.
- Pickaway Correctional Institution- located in Orient, this is a 2000 capacity prison for men and includes 2 hours weekly of music therapy and music therapy consultation.

OhioHealth Riverside Hospital--Dempsey Center Support Group & Neurochoir

 Located at OhioHealth Riverside Hospital, this support group and small ensemble meets once a week for 45 minutes both virtually and at the Dempsey Center to promote neurological rehabilitation.

Westerville Schools - ED Classrooms

 Westerville School District is located in Westerville, OH. Several schools have classrooms, which serve students with Emotional and Behavioral Disorders. Currently there are 8 classrooms that receive 30 minutes each with 5 - 10 minutes of documentation.
